Recruiting Department/Research Unit: Department of Education, Cultural Heritage and Tourism

Title: Art and community. Cultural heritage for post-earthquake social reconstruction between widespread heritage and museums. Surveys and proposals in the earthquake crater areas of the provinces of Macerata.

Offer description:

The research will take place in two sample areas located in the province of Macerata, specifically in the centers brought together in the museum network "Le Città Visibili" (Gualdo, San Ginesio, Tolentino). The assumption is that the local historical-artistic heritage, not always and not yet adequately known and subjected to alterations and displacements after the 2016 earthquake, is a vehicle of social cohesion for local communities since it is an expression of the history of the territory and an integral part of the living environment, which needs to be restored and made usable again for citizens and residents. The objective is to create the conditions for a better use of the heritage primarily for the benefit of citizenship, but also for tourism purposes, in the awareness that cultural heritage, especially in the form of the "diffuse museum" is a key element of sustainable tourism. The assignee will therefore be expected to collaborate and carry out a series of activities including: identifying and taking a census of the cultural heritage and art objects that remained in situ after the earthquake, or relocated to other locations (superintendencies, equipped depots); finding a photographic documentation of destroyed or damaged heritage; to conduct a survey of the conditions of museum endowment and performance in the earthquake areas; to analyze the interactions of museums/equipped depots with schools, associations, local communities; and to analyze the cultural and museum-based tourism offerings in the sample area. The ultimate goal is the development of guidelines and concrete proposals for multi-level enhancement: for local communities, for schools, for tourism.
