Title: The nexus between valorisation of Unesco Heritage and Local Development

Offer description:

The research project aims to analyze the economic and social impact of the inscription of cultural heritage elements in the UNESCO World Heritage List. The focus is on the components of the inscribed sites and on the territorial areas of reference. An in-depth analysis of the economic, cultural and social dynamics activated in the territories is carried out, as well as a comparison between municipalities that host inscribed sites within them, the neighboring municipalities outside the perimeter and the communities of reference. This leads to policy indications for the development and for the structural, economic, social and cultural change of the territories.

The work is particularly interdisciplinary and is fueled by both qualitative and quantitative analysis techniques.

The activity is carried out in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture.
