**Title:** Me.Di.Ce.Hum. Census of Latin Medical-Didactic Literature in the Age of Humanism (sec. XV). Texts, Genres, Authors, Sources and Traditions. Digital Repertory and Case Studies.

#### Offer description:

The research, which is an integral part of the PRIN 2022 project From Heavens to Earth. The scientific didactic Literature of the15th and16th Centuries, is aimed at the realization of a digital repertory of didactic Latin Literature in the medical-scientific field produced in the 15th century, with particular regard to the inter-Adriatic area. The activity is divided into three operational lines: 1) basic research, aimed at the realization of the census of the manuscript and printed tradition, the retrieval of the bibliographic sources necessary for the reconstruction of the state of the art, the identification of case studies; 2) applied research, aimed at the digital repertorization of the census materials; 3) integrated research, aimed at the connection with the complementary activities carried out by the other units involved in the project. The assignee will collaborate with the Macerata research team, actively participating in the organization of scientific, educational, seminar, conference and third mission initiatives promoted within the project.
