Offer description:

The *InnovaEU* project aims to analyze the role of research and innovation processes in Europe in the context of the Tenth Framework Programme (FP10), focusing on how it fosters the transition towards a knowledge-based, sustainable, and resilient economy: rights and economic development. FP10 represents a milestone in harmonizing research and innovation policies among Member States, with the objective of strengthening the EU's global competitiveness.

The project is structured into 2 main areas:

- 1. **Policies and strategic priorities**: Analysis of FP10's thematic priorities, such as the green transition, digitalization, and strategic autonomy, and their impact on research dynamics.
- 2. **Collaboration, research & project management**: Study of collaboration networks among universities, research institutions, and industry at the European level. A particular attention is placed on the role of research & project management.

Objectives:

- Identify successful models for the dissemination and application of knowledge within the EU, expecially with reference to the role of research & project management.
- Propose strategies to overcome barriers to transnational cooperation.
- Explore the potential of an integrated European system for research and innovation, aligned with the concept of the "fifth freedom" proposed in the Letta report.
