Title: Normative and Digital Solutions to address constitutional challenges posed by online election campaigns

Offer description - Funded by the European Union - Next Generation EU - PNRR mission 4, component 2, investment 1.1

The research project, which is part of the PRIN 2022 PNRR "RightNets", aims to address the phenomenon of online electoral campaigns and the challenges it poses to the foundations of representative democracy. The research will involve the interdisciplinary collaboration of computer scientists and constitutional law scholars. The former will provide anonymized data from social networks about election campaigns, and the latter will address the constitutional implications of the data obtained and analyze the data results from the perspective of the rule of law and representative democracy. In the context of electoral campaigns that increasingly take place via social media, the general objective of the project is to examine the challenges posed to the transparency and accountability of the electoral processes. First of all the research will focus on the impact of the phenomenon of inauthentic bot-generated engagement in terms of "pollution" of the social media ecosystem during electoral processes; identifying legal instruments and political strategies to ensure an online political competition that is fair and free of fraudulent means. Secondly, the research will focus on the origin of political ads by setting up tools capable of analysing the flow of private funding used for online propaganda in order to assess the extent of possible foreign interference in election campaigns (in financial terms and/or in influencing public opinion) and envisaging regulatory and policy counter-measures.
