Title: *The protection of animal welfare in the meat chain and in denominational rites: case-law and regulatory aspects in comparative perspective*

Offer description:

Animal welfare is a legally protected value in European, EU and many non-EU legal systems both through legislation and case law. In particular, the valorisation of animal welfare is becoming increasingly important within the meat supply chain and poses specific critical issues in slaughtering practices that, under specific denominational practices, produce halal or kosher meat. Looking at what Courts have ruled, the survey will take into consideration the most significant and indicative judgments and approaches, just as on the regulatory front it will allow to know the legislative solutions adopted in the different legal systems in order to reconcile the needs of food production and consumption with those of animal welfare.
