The research activity fits into the goals of the Prin 2022 Digital Leopardian Letters (EDiLe), which aims to create the first operational and complete core of the Digital Leopardian Library, an author database promoted by the CNSL of Recanati in partnership with the University of Macerata, the National Library of Naples and the Central Institute for the Unique Catalogue. The main product of the project will consist in the cataloging/inventorying, metadating and digitizing of the approximately 2000 letters that, in the present state of knowledge, make up the Letters of Giacomo Leopardi. The recruited research fellow will contribute to the preparation of the database by collaborating with his counterpart recruited by the Pavia research unit, partner of EDiLe.
