**Title:** Shared places: rethinking public spaces

**Offer description:**

Contemporary society is increasingly multicultural and inhabited by differences that meet and clash, demanding recognition. This opens up unprecedented opportunities and, at the same time, also many difficulties: new ways of sharing and renewing the configurations of living together have to be invented. The technologies based on artificial intelligence, moreover, which are increasingly present on a massive scale, cannot be understood as mere instruments, but constitute a complexification of the "milieu" of existence. In this context, considering the "transcendental placeness" of human beings (placeness of situation, not of position), it can be hypothesized that public places – in their various expressions and forms – can constitute important premises for the coming to generative possibilities of new forms of communication, relationship, and sharing, through the capacity to valorize conflict in a creative way and to develop practices for inhabiting the world in a non-violent manner. The research will develop accurate phenomenological investigations and critical reflections, will identify case-studies and the spectrum of emerging issues in the ethical and political spheres, and will also take the form of a research that implies the submission of projects within the "Horizon Europe" Framework Program for Research.
