Title: Make it Explicit: The Ontology of Fiction and Literary Interpretation

Offer description - Funded by the European Union - Next Generation EU - PNRR mission 4, component 2, investment 1.1

The research activity will be part of the PRIN 2022 PNRR project "Make it Explicit: Documenting interpretations of literary fictions with conceptual formal models (MITE)". Within the local research unit based in Macerata, the researcher will be required to conduct research on the ontology of fiction in connection with literary interpretation. More precisely, working together with the head of the local unit and the other members, the research will explore the existence, identity and persistence conditions of literary fictional objects within existing ontological theories of fiction and the main philosophical theories of literary interpretation. S/he will contribute to a survey on the connections between such fields, focusing on questions such as whether and how interpretation acts can ground or change the aforementioned conditions, and whether and how fictional objects can 'migrate' from one work to another through rewritings. Later on, it is expected that the researcher will provide at least one original contribution on these topics. The research will join the activities connected with the project and collaborate to organize them.
