**Title:** *Truces and peace agreements in political dynamic among and inside civic communities in Umbria and Marche (Fourteenth and Fifteenth Centuries)*

**Offer description - Funded by the European Union – Next Generation EU – PNRR mission 4, component 2, investment 1.1**

In the endemic conflict, internal and external, that characterized the political life of the cities of Umbria and Marche between the fourteenth and fifteenth centuries, there was no shortage of attempts to contain the damages of the use of violence through the conclusion of "pacts" between the parties involved. The research will be devoted to an analysis of the archival and narrative sources that testify to the terms of these agreements, paying particular attention to the temporal dimension, whether they are explicitly designated as truces or whether the language of "peace" is adopted to characterize temporary suspensions of clashes. The interactions between city institutions, local ecclesiastical institutions, and the papal government that decisively influenced the success or failure of these agreements will be investigated as well.
