The research activity aims at carrying out a theoretical analysis of the aspects of care and caregiving in the light of changes in the national sociodemographic context (ageing population, women's participation in employment). Here, work is required on secondary data on family structures, caregiving patterns and gender differences. In particular, a sociological analysis of organisational practices of work-family balance and caregiver support through both quantitative and qualitative case-studies methodology in different Italian realities is also envisaged.
