Title: Development of a statistical analysis on inequalities in education.

Offer description:

The research activity aims to identify key success factors for quality education for students at primary and secondary level (students aged 6-18). The aim is to collect, analyse and summarise data to assess inequalities in education over time in 31 countries, with a focus on southern and western Europe. Part of the activities is dedicated to understanding to what extent different databases can be made directly comparable and to produce a feasibility study, also in relation to the national policies of the different countries. More in detail, the different methodological approaches reported in the literature will be analysed, identifying and cataloguing longitudinal, national or regional data archives and defining a methodology for documentary research. A further part of the research activity will concern the design of a semi-structured questionnaire to collect information on the presence of quantitative databases/research projects with a longitudinal approach; the questionnaire will be submitted to several stakeholders in the 31 countries included in the mapping, and the results will be analysed and disseminated.
